Based in Osaka, she has built up the brand Laifu to convey the charm of the fabric produced from the manual labor she encountered by personally going all over Japan. In 2007, she acted as the art director for the Japanese brand Tango at the Tango Textile Exhibition held in Paris, France. Afterwards, she was involved in the development of fabrics for Tango, and assisted in the renewal of Tango textiles with a focus on art galleries and department stores.




#### **Hayato Aoki**
